The other can be any non-relative who knows you well (including another school professional, Rabbi, employer, etc.) **Deadline for receipt of application and request for letters of recommendation and transcripts: December 8, 2021. Deadline for receipt of letters of recommendation and transcript: December 10, 2021.** 

Semi-finalists will be notified in **mid-January 2022**. Interviews for semi-finalists will take place **late January through February March 2022**. Fellows will be notified of acceptance **in March 2022**.
