

Get Ready for the 2024 Bronfman Fellowship!

Every year, 26 Jewish teens get the opportunity of a lifetime: a free Fellowship-year experience, beginning with a summer in Israel and North America, in which they embark on transformative, deeply personal journeys. Inspired by a stellar faculty of Rabbis and educators, Fellows explore existential questions and Jewish ideas while building friendships with peers who are as curious as they are, joining a lifelong community that inspires them to change the world for the better. They also expand their worldviews

through intensive encounters with a parallel group of Israeli peers.

The Fellowship begins with a free, immersive summer in Israel and North America in the summer between the Fellows' junior and senior years of high school, followed by monthly virtual experiences and a winter and spring seminar in the United States. Fellows continue their association with the Fellowship through our extraordinarily active, 1,400+ alumni community.

Eligibility and Important Dates

To be eligible for The Bronfman Fellowship 2024 cohort, you must:

- Be in the 11th grade in the fall of 2023.
- Self-identify as Jewish.
- Be from the United States or Canada.

The application will go live in early September, and the deadline will be in December of 2023. The Fellowship begins the summer following 11th grade.

The Bronfman Fellowship Year at a Glance

The Bronfman Fellowship is a transformative, year-long experience for a cohort of 26 intellectually adventurous young people who want to see the world through a lens broader than their own. It includes:

- A five-week, immersive summer in Israel and the U.S. – In between their junior and senior years of high school, Fellows encounter the land and people of Israel, study major issues in contemporary Jewish life, and meet with some of today's most influential figures. Inspired by a diverse faculty of Rabbis, educators, and artists, the Fellows have the opportunity to immerse themselves in a wide range of Jewish texts and ideas as well as artistic workshops.
- Monthly virtual meetings Opportunities for reflection, deep dialogue, and processing with the same small group of Fellows and a faculty member.
- Winter Seminar Several days when the Fellows and faculty meet to reconnect and continue to learn and grow together.
- Spring Context Seminar A retreat in a Northeastern U.S. city – generally NYC or Washington D.C. – to meet up with the Israeli Fellows who visit the U.S. at this time.
- Beyond Bronfman process Fellows choose a question, topic, or idea from their Fellowship summer that they would like to explore further. When they return home, they embark on a process of deep exploration with the help of alumni, staff, and faculty.


